

# 2024 Lynda Dunlap Cosey Scholarship Program Graduating High School Seniors

## **GUIDELINES**

### **Program Guidelines & Priorities**

- 1. Seeking graduating seniors attending high school in Louisiana and who attend schools in the following parishes, East Baton Rouge, East Feleciana, Baker Zachary and with a record of leadership and volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- 2. Applicant must complete high school by the spring of 2024.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale, excluding home school studies) and plan to attend an accredited College, University, HBCU. (HBCU is defined as "historically black colleges and universities".)
- 4. Applicant must apply to and be accepted into an accredited College, University, HBCU by July 1, 2024, and must plan to matriculate at the accredited College, University, HBCU for the Fall 2024/Spring 2025 academic year (enrollment must begin in the Fall) with the intention of maintaining full-time status for the entire year.
- 5. Applicant must be a United States Citizen
- 6. Applicant must intend on pursuing an undergraduate degree.
- 7. Applicant must submit two letters of recommendation that are specific to the application for the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Nu Gamma Omega Chapter, Nu Gamma Omega Educational and Charitable Foundation, Inc., Scholarship Program:
  - one from a high school teacher, counselor, or principal.
  - one from a local community member or officer of an organization in which the applicant is affiliated.
- 8. Do not submit more than two letters. The letters of recommendation must be signed by the person writing the letter; digital or electronic signatures will not be accepted and will void your application.
- 9. The letters may either be included with your application submission or emailed separately from the person writing your recommendation.
- 10. The most recent official electronic transcript must be sent directly from your high school.
- 11. The official transcript(s) may be sent electronically via email from the school directly or from a transcript service such as Credentials Solutions, Parchment, or other transcript service.
- 12. We will not accept transcripts sent via email from applicants. DO NOT SEND IT WITH YOUR APPLICATION.

- 13. If your official transcript cannot be sent electronically, a school official can email transcripts to <a href="mailto:ngolyndacosey@gmail.com">ngolyndacosey@gmail.com</a> and/or <a href="mailto:akangoantib@gmail.com">akangoantib@gmail.com</a>. The email address must be associated with the sending institution.
- 14. Transcripts sent from Hotmail, Gmail, Yahoo, or other generic email providers will not be accepted.
- 15. If your school is no longer in operation, you must confirm that your academic records can still be obtained. If your transcript is no longer available, contact us at <a href="mailto:ngolyndacosey@gmail.com">ngolyndacosey@gmail.com</a> and/or <a href="mailto:akangoantib@gmail.com">akangoantib@gmail.com</a>.
- 16. Submit a personal resume and essay with your application.
- 17. Applications and all supporting documents must be received by May 1, 2024. Late applications and supporting documents will not be accepted.
